On asked whether she had participated in any competitions, she says, "I haven't taken

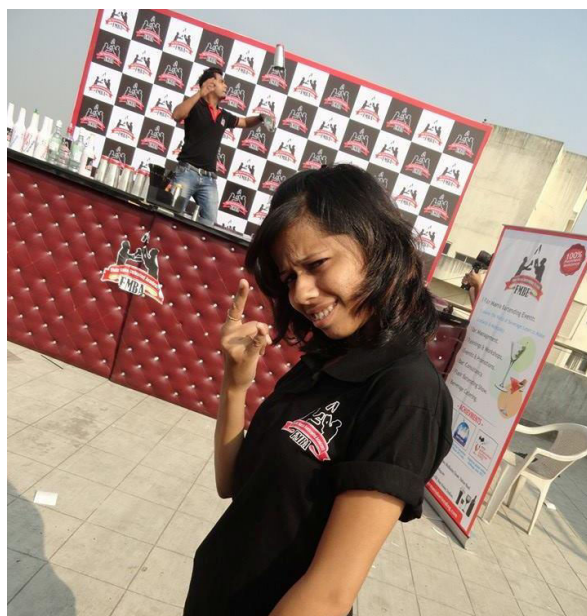
part in any competitions so far as I want to gain more on the job experience. Once I get that, I do look forward in participating in bartending competitions"
